


Best Practice Summary Sheet

Assisting a patient to register for a My Health Record

Before undertaking these steps, please ensure that:

- Your practice and procedure manual has been updated to include an Assisted Registration policy.
- You have been authorised by your practice to register patients for a My Health Record.

- Your user permissions allow 'My Health Record Registration'.
- The patient has read the `Essential Information about assisted registration and your privacy in the My Health Record system' document, available at www.myhealthrecord.gov.au
- The patient's Healthcare Identifier has been validated in the patient details page.
- 1 Locate and access the patient's local record.


Click the My Health Record menu tab and then Register for My Health Record.



Select the Identity Verification Method.

Click Next.

The patient's details will automatically populate.








Select the **consent** for healthcare information to be included in the patient's My Health Record.

Select an **Identity Verification Code (IVC) delivery method** from the drop down menu.

Click Register.

An **IVC code** is shown (depending on the IVC delivery method selected) which can be printed and provided to the patient.

Click OK.

PCEHR means the My Health Record, formerly the "Personally Controlled Electronic Health Record", within the meaning of the *My Health Records Act 2012* (Cth), formerly called the *Personally Controlled Electronic Health Records Act 2012* (Cth).
